She also showed one of innovations created by students of the Center, which is a robot equipped to deliver medicine to patients in a timely manner, in order to achieve maximum medical benefits in hospitals. She pointed out that the Center provides specialized services for discovering gifted students through specialized scientific programs that provide guidance for gifted students, parents and teachers, in addition to the Center's participation on educating the community regarding the field of talent.

The Center offers a number of other programs such as vacation enrichment program and a range of extra-curricular educational, scientific and intellectual experiences acquired by gifted students. Enrichment programs contribute to satisfy the scientific and mental needs of students through programs that pro-vide full scientific, social and psychological support, and help develop and invest their energies and abilities in a stimulating scientific environment.

Supportive Environment The Center's pavilion in the Competition also reviewed Fab Lab UAE initiative, which is the first fab lab in the UAE to be established in accordance with international standards and specifications of the fab lab centers to create a supportive environment for innovation and integrated infrastructure. This would be done through labs, which pro-vide the latest equipment, tools, programs and training courses in the world of digital fabrication for all segments of the community. This initiative also helps equipping schools with mini-labs that provide digital manufacturing technology to students, and draws young people's attention to digital literacy at early ages, leading to the establishing the seed of innovation, and opening up wider horizons that help turn their ideas into reality.
